# STEAM TRAP TESTING

NZ Safety Blackwoods provide a condensate discharge location (CDL) survey. Our technicians will inspect your CDL's and test your steam traps using the TLV TrapMan precision diagnostic hardware (TM5N) and software (TrapManager)\*.

A site survey consists of collecting CDL information, creating a standardised database, tagging each CDL, inspecting all steam traps, and providing a report, analysis, and other deliverables. When the Service is employed regularly, maintaining the lowest failure rate, and most optimal CDL conditions become a reality.

\*TrapMan hardware and software accuracy has been validated by Lloyd's Register

## The survey report includes

- a) Overall Failure analysis and annual leakage monetary loss
- **b)** Proposal including return on investment
- c) Steam system recommendation
- **d)** Log report of all traps including faulty traps that needs to be replaced or overhauled.



## Number of traps tested per day

- **a)** For a new site this is typically 80 traps a day (to allow time for information to be obtained, produced and location of traps)
- **b)** For a previously surveyed site this is typically between 100-110 traps per day.

Condensate discharge location surveys charged at \$1500 + GST a day. Minimum Charge  $\frac{1}{2}$  Day. (\$800 + GST).
